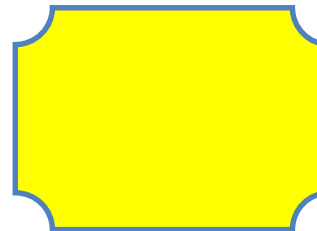

Llebeig lighthouse emits 1 flash every 7.5 seconds.

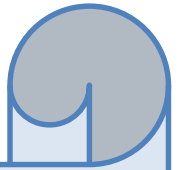
Calafiguera lighthouse emits 4 flashes every 20 seconds.
